The city serves us as a well of information to draw and paint from. We use people as our models as we wait for the train, seat at a cafe, park or museum. As artists we see a mass of bodies in their nakedness, their mortality, their reality. It does not have a particularly erotic effect, this x-ray experience...It probably happens because every week, for at least one long session, we seat to draw "from the nude," which is simply the nakedness inside our clothes.
